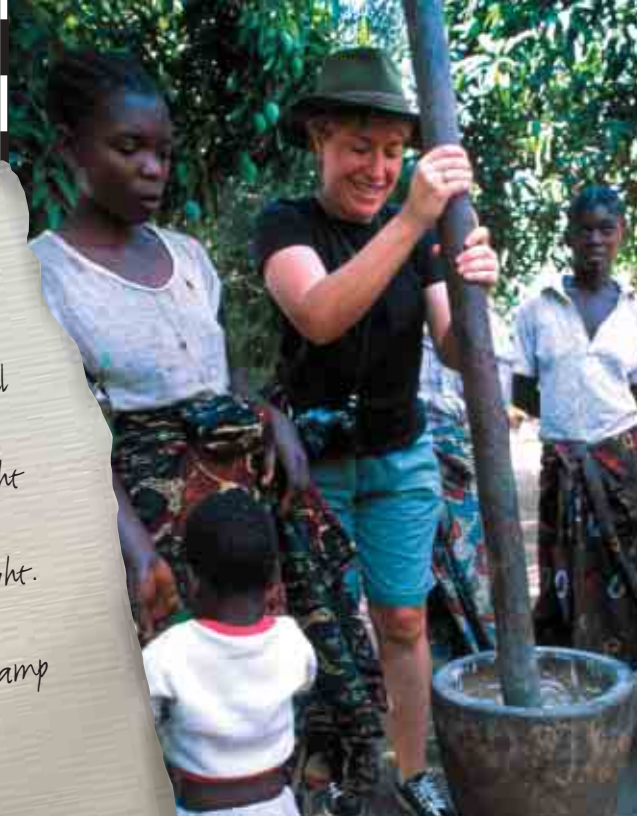
13 DAYS — ZAMBIA
