3 NIGHTS CAPE TOWN / 4 NIGHTS KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE / 2 NIGHTS JOHANNESBURG

South Africa presents a tantalizing treat for all senses. While your eyes will feast on the sights of the Cape, your nose will be delighted by the distinctive fragrances of traditional Cape Malay cuisine. The delicate texture of local chocolates and fine nuances of South African wines will stimulate your taste buds. Your ears will be energized by the sounds of the bush and your close-up encounters with lions and elephants make you feel that you can reach out and touch them. This safari is sensational!

Day 1 Cape Town, South Africa

Your lodging in the picturesque winelands, just a short distance from town, provides an excellent base for your time in the Cape.

Day 2 - 3 Cape Town

Embark on two days of private exploration of the Cape peninsula. First a journey to Cape Point, followed by a private cellar tour and a special dinner at Catharina's, Steenberg's fine dining restaurant. Your second day starts on a high, atop Table Mountain, then explore the local flavors with a class on Cape Malay cooking. The rest of the afternoon is spent sampling local chocolates, olives and, of course, wines.

Day 4 - 5 Kruger Private Reserve

Depart Cape Town for two days and nights in the Sabi Sands, one of the most densely populated wildlife enclaves. The region is home to 147 species of mammals and over 500 species of birds that have been documented in the region.

Day 6 - 7 Kruger Private Reserve

Fly north to the Timbavati for your next two nights. Visit the Hoedspruit

Endangered Species Centre for a look at a number of ongoing projects involving cheetahs and wild dogs and make friends with the largest land dwelling mammal, the elephant. Then mount his back and explore the bush for a unique gameviewing experience.

Day 8 Johannesburg

Fly on to Johannesburg today and wash off the dust of the bush while enjoying the comfort of your award winning hotel, repeatedly voted "World's Leading Boutique Hotel."

Day 9 Johannesburg

The morning starts with an excursion through Soweto for a closer look at life inside a township followed by a visit to the Apartheid Museum. The day concludes with a truly memorable dining experience in a very exclusive seat at the Chef's Table in the kitchen at The Saxon. From this enviable location you'll witness ALL the kitchen magic.

Day 10 Depart

Choose between a visit to the hotel's spa for the signature sound treatment or a private half day excursion into town for last minute shopping.
